

HC warns VFI of contempt over delay in decision on MP Volleyball Assn

RECOGNITION CASE

Indore Bench of Madhya Pradesh High Court has directed Volleyball Federation of India (VFI) of strict compliance with its earlier order regarding the recognition application of Madhya Pradesh Volleyball Association (MPVA) warning of contempt action in case of further delay.

Justice Pranay Verma passed the order while hearing a civil contempt petition filed by the MPVA, alleging non-compliance of the court's November 18, 2023 order. In that ruling, the HC had directed the VFI to decide the Association's pending application for recognition within 45 days. The Association submitted that the court's order had not been implemented within the stipulated time, forcing it to approach the HC again.

Taking a serious note of the grievance, the HC directed the VFI to positively comply with the November 18 order within a further period of 30 days from the date of receipt of the certified copy of the present order. With these directions, the contempt petition was disposed of.
